Flower Pressing

Make sure you get permission before
picking any flowers.

- 1) Gather clean flowers free of spots
blemishes. Collect them on a sunny day
when they are not wet from rain or dew.
- 2) Place the flower face down in a
telephone book lined with paper.
- 3) Close the book, weigh it down, and
leave undisturbed for seven to 10 days.
- 4) Display on paper.

Garden Art

Create a piece of art using what you can
find in your garden. Take a photograph of

Plant Research

Find out about a flower or plant of your
choice. Find out what it is called and what
its Latin name is, when it flowers, where it
likes to grow . Describe what it looks like
