**Tues 8<sup>th</sup> May**- visit to “Out of the cave” F2 only. More details to follow.

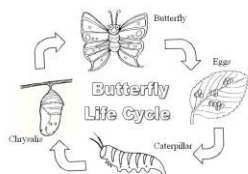
**Thurs 24<sup>th</sup> May**- UGLY BUG BALL. Dress up as a bug.
