Mon 23rd April- FOREST SCHOOL EVENT. Building bug hotels and being creative with mud.

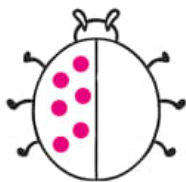
Tues 8th May- visit to “Outside the cave” F2 only. More details to follow.
