Dear Parents / Carers,

We are delighted to announce that King Edwin Primary will be hosting Gizmos' Science Club for Key Stage One (KS1) children. The club will initially run for five weeks during the Summer Term, with possibility of it continuing further into the academic year. Gizmos' Science club will take place on Tuesdays and finish 4.30pm.

During these sessions, children will be exploring various areas of science as well as technology and engineering. These sessions are affiliated with the British Science Association to raise awareness and the profile of science in primary schools. Over the term, children will create and build their own science projects which they keep and bring home, including projects such as: rocketry, crystal making, optics, engine building and chemistry projects (Please ask about the incredible assembly that Gizmos' Lab provided us earlier this half term).

As the club is being provided by Gizmos' Lab, there will be a cost of £5 per session; they do offer a 10% discount on siblings taking part in the club in order to make the club more affordable. The first five weeks will be a trial period to gauge whether school is able to generate enough interest in the club in order to sustain it over longer periods (Summer Term 2).
