Thurs 24th May- UGLY BUG BALL. Dress up as a bug.

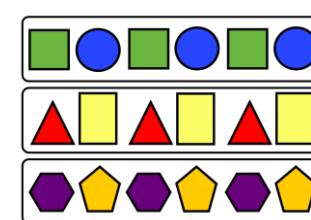
Forest Schools
