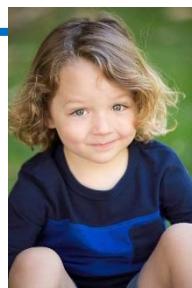

## PHYSICAL Challenge



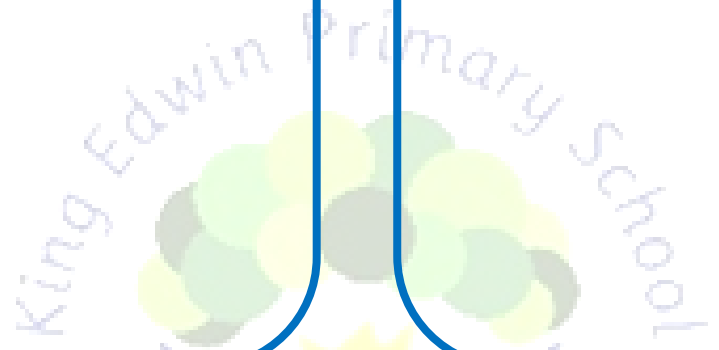
