Use the paper bag provided by school to fill with items for our autumn exploration table.

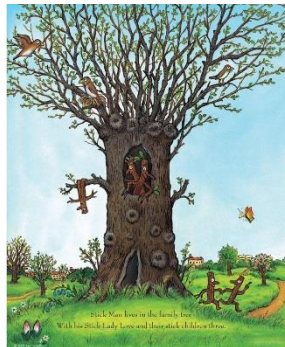
READING Challenge

You can enjoy stories, reading and finding text in many different environments. We would love to see photographs of your child in their favourite and interesting places looking at print such as books, signs, menus etc.

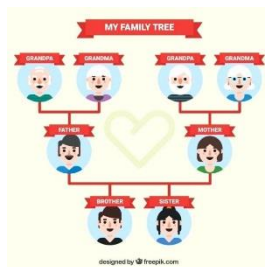


PEOPLE Challenge

Patterns are everywhere! And they can help with mathematical concepts.

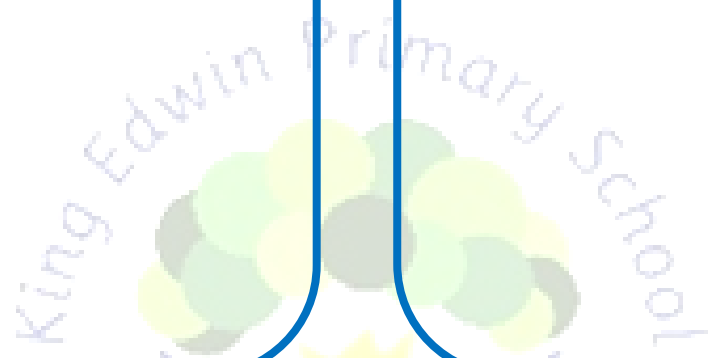
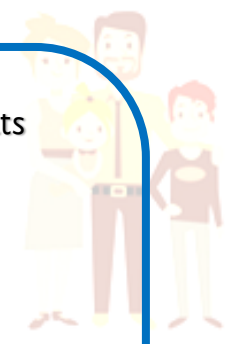
